## 2018 Scholarship Fund

On June 3, 2018, 91 of the most advanced music students from around the country and the world will arrive at Round Top Festival Institute for six weeks of study during the 2018 Round Top Music Festival. They will be mentored by 40 of the most outstanding faculty and work with seven renowned conductors of international stature.

Texas is the most represented state, with a combined 25 students attending from the following ten schools:

- Rice, Shepherd School of Music
- Southern Methodist University
- Stephen F. Austin State University
- Texas Christian University
- Texas Tech University
- University of Houston
- University of North Texas
- University of Texas at Austin
- University of Texas Rio Grande Valley

Thirty-six universities and conservatories outside of Texas are being represented.

Each year, \$6,000 needs to be raised for each student attending the Institute. Efforts to secure funds for the 2018 Music Festival are ongoing. The Institute is grateful to everyone who participated in making the 2017 festival a success, as well as to those who have already donated to the efforts for 2018. **Our goal is to raise a total of \$546,000 to provide full tuition scholarships for the 91 students who have been accepted to attend the 2018 festival.**
