



WEDDING ROOM RATES

- Rates are based on double occupancy. Cost per extra guest - \$33.90.
- Rates include 6% hotel tax and 7% city tax.
- We offer a variety of rooms to accommodate 1 to 4 guests.
- Each room has a private bath.
- Complimentary continental breakfast in Menke House Dining Room.

MENKE HOUSE (#16 on Campus Map)

Restored Victorian-style house

Bed arrangements vary (1 double, 2 doubles, 1 queen, or 2 twins per room). Each room has a private bath. Shower and tub in all rooms except Room 3 (2 twin beds, shower only). All rooms are upstairs. Not ADA-compliant.

Rate: \$169.50 per night based on double occupancy.
\$33.90 per night per extra guest.



LOG HOUSE (#15 on Campus Map)

A luxurious residence nestled among tall trees

Bed arrangements vary (1 king, 1 queen, or 2 twins per room). Each room has a private bath with shower. Multi-level. Not ADA-compliant.

Rate: Rooms 1, 3, 4, 5 - \$169.50 per night
Room 2 - \$203.40 per night (queen suite)
All rates based on double occupancy.



ARTIST RESIDENCES I, II, and III (#1, #2, and #3 on the Campus Map)

Newest student residences in west corner of the campus

3 twin beds per room with a private bath. Shower only, no tub. Several rooms are upstairs. 2 rooms are ADA compliant.

Rate: \$135.60 per night based on double occupancy.
\$33.90 per night per extra guest.



STUDIO DORMS (#23 on Campus Map)

Cozy dorm rooms on north end of the Concert Hall

3 or 4 twin beds per room with private bath. Shower and tub. All rooms downstairs. Not ADA-compliant.

Rate: \$115.26 per night based on double occupancy.
\$33.90 per night per extra guest.





LODGING RULES

- Reservation must be paid in full when reservation is made.
- No refunds. All sales final.
- No unauthorized guests.
- No pets. (Service animals are allowed.)
- No candles or sources of open flame.
- Smoking is allowed only on the porches of the buildings where butt receptacles are provided.
- Late arrivals may pick up their key by the entrance to the office (#18 on Campus Map), which is located at the back of the Concert Hall.

LIMITED AMENITIES

- Linens and towels are provided.
- None of the following are available:
 - ◆ No toiletries (i.e., shampoo, bath soap, etc.)
 - ◆ No television, refrigerator, microwave, coffeemaker, blow dryer, iron/ironing board or clock radio
 - ◆ No food vending machines
 - ◆ No ice machines
 - ◆ No housekeeping services
 - ◆ No room service
- Vending machines with water and sodawater are available outside the Service Building (#22 on Campus Map).
- Complimentary breakfast in the Menke House from 8 am to 9 am is included. Food service is not available any other time. (#16 on Campus Map)
- Campus-wide wifi is available. However, due to our rural location, the quality of the signal is less than optimal.
